also an option.

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#### 1. Vaccine Clinics

a) Many municipalities plan to do vaccine clinics and are offering them now as well. Not many residents are interested in receiving the vaccines. There is misinformation on whether it is an additional dose or a new vaccine. Many are getting their vaccines at drug stores instead of from the health department.

#### 2. Opioid funds

- a) North Attleboro and Taunton Health Departmentes do not have access to the funds. They are just starting to be involved in the conversation on how to spend the funds
- b) Geri is in the discovery phase in Rehoboth, to come up with plans on how to spend the funds. Could be interested in working together to share funds with some of the communities
- Attleboro has spent the funds through the police and schools.
   They have hired two staff members Peer Support and a Recovery Resource Navigator
- d) Many people will attend the MAHB training this weekend and learn more about this issue. We will revisit next week.
